LEWISVILLE, TX, **PUBLIC ART MASTER PLAN**

Lewisville, TX, 2017

Bressi and Via were retained by the City of Lewisville to develop a master plan that would help the city implement a new public art policy.

Lewisville is a historic agricultural town which, because of its proximity to Dallas Fort-Worth airport, has become desirable for corporate relocations. Significant residential development followed.

The art master plan built on the framework of Lewisville 2020, a well-regarded comprehensive plan that the city was activity using to manage it projects and programs. The public art plan focused its recommendations on the key goals of Lewisville 2020: preserving the historic Old Town while reinvesting in it, creating a "green centerpiece" open space in the floodplain of the Trinity River, creating greenways that connect this main space to neighborhoods throughout the city, and the redevelopment of gateway artworks at freeway interchanges and regional rail stations.

The plan outlined approximately 20 projects for the City to take on, from gateway artworks to the entrancs to Old Town, a residency in the Citysponsored environmenetal learning center, and artworks connected to public spaces built through redevelopment.
